

## **Health (including Emotional Wellbeing)**

All prescribed medication is administered by a member of staff trained in first aid; once it has been signed in by a parent at the office and parental consent has been given.

All Pupils with a medical condition which require adjustments, above that of other pupils, will have a medical plan drawn up by our parent liaison officer in consultation with parents. This plan will be reviewed annually, where applicable, and discussed with a pupil's new class teacher during a transition meeting towards the end of the summer term.

In the regrettable event of a medical emergency, appropriate medical assistance will be sought and parents informed as soon as possible.

A large number of staff within St. Clare's are trained to administer first aid and training is renewed regularly.

St. Clare's follow a structured SRE (sex relationship education) programme and details can be found on the website.

An induction pack is given to all supply teaching staff which includes a concern reporting sheet, a visual medical list, a nut allergy warning, and a supply feedback sheet.
